the story of the making of the new testament is one in which scrolls bumped across cobbled roman roads and pitched through rolling mediterranean seas finally finding their destinations in stuffy dimly lit christian house churches in corinth or colossae there they were read aloud and reread handled and copied forwarded and collected studied and treasured and eventually they were brought together to make up our new testament this revised and expanded edition of the making of the new testament is a

textbook introduction to the origin collection copying and canonizing of the new testament documents like shrewd detectives reading subtle whispers of evidence biblical scholars have studied the trail of clues and pieced together the story of these books arthur patzia tells the story answering our many questions how were books and documents produced in the first century what motivated the early christians to commit teaching and narrative and vision to papyrus how were the stories and sayings of jesus circulated handed down and shaped into gospels what do we know about ancient letter writing secretaries and copy shops why were four gospels included instead of just one how were paul s letters sent here and there gathered into a single collection who decided and by what criteria which documents would be included in the new testament explore these questions and more about these scriptures whose everyday gritty story rings true to their extraordinary message the palpable mystery of the word made flesh

lukan narrative takes its readers into god s story how his salvation plan in jesus began on the slopes of judea and at the sea of galilee ending on the hill of calvary and the mount of olives yet moving on and telling how the spirit descended onto the temple mount empowering god s people who then began to fulfill the given mandate in the presence of the spirit yet readers of luke acts throughout the centuries have had a meandering journey as they have tried to understand the narrative s persuasion and spirit references this book seeks to bring awareness to these challenges by some of the most respected pentecostal biblical scholars and systematicians here their vigorous labor with the questions of hermeneutics and theology in relation to lukan writings have come to fruition these contributions have been collected as a festschrift in honor and celebration of the career of roger stronstad a pentecostal biblical scholar whose contribution to lukan studies have moved pentecostal scholarship from shadows into daylight the editor of this volume invites the readers of lukan narrative to journey together on the road to emmaus as we continue to ponder the events in the past the present and the future

reviewing ten important verses using the traditional areas of text critical inquiry manuscript evidence internal criteria such as style and transcriptional probabilities rodgers turns our attention to important but neglected narrative features indicated by quotations allusions and echoes of the old testament these references to the story told in the scriptures of israel shed new light on the passages considered offering fresh material and greater perspective for making judgments about the original text
