kriminalität und recht in nationalsozialistischen ghettos ein thema das auf den ersten blick vielleicht verblüfft sah man doch das leben der von den deutschen verfolgten und schließlich mehrheitlich ermordeten juden

europas eher in einem rechtsfreien raum der absoluten willkür angesiedelt der alle rechtsvorstellungen ad absurdum führte und doch entwickelte sich in den ghettos eine eigene rechtssphäre die deutschen erzwangen oft unmittelbar nach der besetzung die einrichtung von sogenannten judenräten ihnen wurde in den ghettos die aufgabe zugewiesen die antijüdischen maßnahmen zu verkünden und zu vollziehen die umsetzung der von den deutschen aufgestellten forderungen nach wertgegenständen und arbeitskräften zu organisieren und letztlich den massenmord reibungsloser zu ermöglichen die judenräte entwickelten neue definitionen von kriminalität und recht die sie mit hilfe der jüdischen polizei von gerichten und gefängnissen im ghetto durchzusetzen versuchten stets ging es dabei um handlungen die als gefahr für die ghettogemeinschaft eingeordnet wurden neben schmuggel gab es delikte wie illegale süßwarenproduktion das fälschen von lebensmittelkarten sexuellen missbrauch und ghettointerne morde svenja bethke zeichnet ein vielschichtiges bild der ghettogemeinschaft bei der es sich entgegen häufigen Überlieferungen nicht einfach um eine solidarische opfergemeinschaft gehandelt hat die als kollektiv ums Überleben kämpft am beispiel der ghettos warschau litzmannstadt und wilna beschreibt svenja bethke auf welche weise die jüdischen instanzen bemüht waren das recht als instrument des schutzes der gemeinschaft und der aufrechterhaltung einer internen moral einzusetzen sie schildert die tragische chancenlosigkeit und den letztlich aussichtslosen versuch einer anpassung an erzwungene lebensverhältnisse

published by the university of nebraska press lincoln and yad vashem jerusalem the holocaust in the soviet union is the most complete account to date of the soviet jews during the world war ii and the holocaust 1941-45 reports records documents and research previously unavailable in english enable yitzhak arad to trace the holocaust in the german occupied territories of the soviet union through three separate periods in which german political and military goals in the occupied territories dictated the treatment of the jews arad's examination of the differences between the holocaust in the soviet union compared to other european nations reveals how nazi ideological attacks on the soviet union which included war on judeo bolshevism led to harsher treatment of jews in the soviet union than in most other occupied territories this historical narrative presents a wealth of information from german russian and jewish archival sources that will be invaluable to scholars researchers and the general public for years to come

historians have mainly seen the ghettos established by the nazis in german occupied eastern europe as spaces marked by brutality tyranny and the systematic murder of the jewish population drawing on examples from the warsaw lodz and vilna ghettos *Dance on the Razor's Edge* explores how in fact highly improvised legal spheres emerged in these coerced and heterogeneous ghetto communities looking at sources from multiple archives and countries svenja bethke investigates how the jewish councils set up on german orders and composed of ghetto inhabitants formulated new definitions of criminal offenses and established legal institutions on their own initiative as a desperate attempt to ensure the survival of the ghetto communities bethke explores how people under these circumstances tried to make sense of everyday lives that had been turned upside down bringing with them pre war notions of justice and morality and she considers the extent to which this rupture led to new judgments on human behaviour in doing so bethke aims to understand how people attempted to use their very limited scope for action in order to survive set against the background of a holocaust historiography that often still seeks for clear categories of good and bad behaviours *Dance on the Razor's Edge* calls for a new understanding of the ghettos as complex communities in an unprecedented emergency situation

weitere angaben inhalt die massenexekutionsstätte ponary in einem waldgebiet unweit der litauischen stadt wilna wurden von juni 1941 bis juli 1944 zwischen 70 000 und 100 000 menschen ermordet die opfer waren zumeist juden aus der region kazimierz sakowicz ein polnischer journalist der nahe der hinrichtungsstätte wohnte war etwa zwei jahre lang zeuge des massenmords er notierte die grausigen geschehnisse auf kleinen zetteln die er anschließend in flaschen steckte und vergrub ende der 80er jahre wurden die kaum mehr leserlichen aufzeichnungen im magazin des jüdischen museums wilna entdeckt und von dr rachel margolis entziffert 1999 veröffentlichte die wissenschaftliche mitarbeiterin des jüdischen museums wilna erstmals das in polnischer sprache geschriebene tagebuch ein jahr später erschien eine gekürzte hebräische ausgabe obwohl die bundesdeutsche justiz 1950 zwei der verantwortlichen massenmörder von ponary aufspüren und

in einem aufsehen erregenden prozess wegen tausendfachen mords zu lebenslangen haftstrafen verurteilen konnte liegen kaum veröffentlichungen über die exekutionsstätte ponary in deutscher sprache vor auch die renommierte enzyklopädie des holocaust erwähnt das massenvernichtungsgelände nur mit wenigen zeilen daher kamen dr rachel margolis und das nürnberg institut für ns forschung überein den nahezu unbekannten text in einer deutschen Übersetzung zu veröffentlichen in ihrem vorwort beschreibt dr margolis die geschichte des tagebuchs und seiner entdeckung abgerundet wird die dokumentation durch einen beitrag von jim g tobias er thematisiert die juristische und historische aufarbeitung des massenmordes in ponary durch die deutschen behörden

das buch macht mit den meldungen und protokollen der sitzungen des bialystoker judenrats bisher kaum bekannte quellen zur geschichte des holocaust zugänglich die dokumente überstanden die vernichtung des bialystoker ghettos und den krieg sie sind wichtige zeugnisse jüdischen lebens und sterbens unter deutscher zwangsherrschaft der theologe dr hans peter stähli fertigte auf der basis einer edition der jiddischsprachigen dokumente samt ihrer hebräischen Übersetzung die 1962 von der gedenkstätte yad vashem herausgegeben wurde eine deutsche Übersetzung aller erhaltenen protokolle und meldungen des bialystoker judenrats an ergänzt werden die quellen durch beiträge von deutschen polnischen und israeli schen historikern soziologen und literaturwissenschaftlern über den bialystoker judenrat und über andere judenräte im besetzten polen

the catalogue of a travelling exhibition on the genocide of lithuanian jews between 1941 44 shown in 1998 at various sites in the area of wuppertal describes the german invasion in summer 1941 the establishment of the ghettos in kovno and vilna the conscription of thousands for forced labor and the mass massacres of the jews in vilna 33 000 jews were murdered during 1941 many of them in ponar where mass graves had been prepared pp 41 61 contain photographs of survivors and details on their fate

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
