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interact 2009 was the 12th of a series of interact international conferences supported by the ifip technical committee 13 on human computer interaction

this year interact was held in uppsala sweden organized by the swedish interdisciplinary interest group for human computer interaction stimdi in cooperation with the department of information technology at uppsala university like its predecessors interact 2009 highlighted both to the academic and to the industrial world the importance of the human computer interaction hci area and its most recent breakthroughs on current applications both experienced hci researchers and professionals as well as newcomers to the hci field interested in designing or evaluating interactive software developing new interaction technologies or investigating overarching theories of hci found in interact 2009 a great forum for communication with people of similar interests to encourage collaboration and to learn interact 2009 had research and practice as its special theme the reason we selected this theme is that the research within the field has drifted away from the practical applicability of its results and that the hci practice has come to disregard the knowledge and development within the academic community

dialogue in multilingual and multimodal communities contains a collection of new articles that approach the study of dialogue through the construct of the community that is a group of people who come together for any number of reasons e.g. geographical location a common goal a search for unity or bonding or a particular set of circumstances the authors address a wide range of topics such as dialogic skills as situated practice the learning of culture and the negotiation of identities between native speakers and l2 learners this volume also investigates how native and non native speakers learn various community based aspects of dialogic interaction such as how to interpret social contexts stances frames and gestures despite different methodologies and frameworks the studies demonstrate that native speakers and l2 learners alike use multiple vocalizations of a language

this volume is a collection of essays on educational issues belonging to educators and researchers from three continents namely africa asia and europe the essays are grouped into four sections the first teaching and teacher education encompasses collaborative learning learning competencies learning strategies pre service teachers and special education the second psychosocial development of children in education is comprised of essays concerned with academic achievement child rights family and gender issues pre schoolers public education school type school violence university students and university youth while the third educational policy investigates issues such as environmental citizenship decision making democracy education gypsies higher education it systems in education migration organisational justice and public and private schools the final section language in teaching is concerned with topics such as bilingual children contrastive analysis english language teaching language skills learning strategies and online teaching materials the book will appeal to educators researchers and students involved in education sciences
