this new edition of bennett s landmark work has been completely updated and is now part of the longman classics in political science series featuring a new foreword by doris graber the book has been thoroughly revised and updated introducing up to the minute case studies the latest research and the rise of a digital information system without changing its lively writing style or its provocative point of view this favorite of both instructors and students is a behind the scenes tour of communication in american politics from the newsroom to the war room to the living room the core question explored in this book is how well does the news as the core of the national political information system serve the needs of democracy in exploring this question we examine how various political actors from presidents and members of congress to interest organizations and citizen activists try to get their messages into the news

bringing together 35 of the most notable contributions of authors such as kenneth burke erving goffman and eric berne this book provides an introduction to the dramaturgical perspective of social actions selections stem from the conception that many real life actions and events can most adequately be understood in terms of drama included are discussions concerned with social theory social interactions roles social psychology social movements ritual and ceremony leadership mass communications and journalism research as well as applied fields such as advertising and political campaign management adapted from book jacket

in this provocative new collection the pulitzer prize winning author daniel j boorstin explores the essential hidden history of the american experience that is overlooked by most historians in twenty four essays divided into five sections the quest for history a by product nation the rhetoric of democracy unsung experiments and the momentum of technology daniel j boorstin examines significant rhythms patterns and institutions of everyday american life from his intimate portraits of such legendary figures as paul revere abigail adams and thomas jefferson to more expansive discussions of historical phenomena such as the therapy of distance and the law of survival of the unread

to understand properly the use of propaganda it is necessary to move beyond the conventional largely descriptive treatments that have been the scholarly norm and to move deeply into a sustained theoretical analysis of the concept in terms of its primary cognitive and ethical deficits through a sequential consideration of the epistemology ethics and metaphysics of propaganda that is one that emerges from a historical review of theories and definitions of the subject author stanley b cunningham provides a radical new window on a much discussed discipline he aims to secure a concept of propaganda that reflects the complexity and sophistication of contemporary mass persuasion practices while avoiding the trivializations and cliches that mark much of propaganda scholarship utilizing an assortment of philosophical analyses and arguments cunningham contends that the culture of propaganda is primarily and originally rooted in a wide range of epistemological disservices that indeed propaganda is neither ethically neutral nor indeterminate and that its lack of ethics constitutes part of its very definition eschewing the methodology of social science this radical study represents the first ever systematic and philosophically structured approach in the 80 year history of propaganda analysis

the work that is described in this book was driven by necessity to meet a real need for managing globally distributed complex networks and it s that pragmatic approach to achieving results managing real world complex networks from end to end that is sometimes missing from the current formal standards bodies vendors providing disparate projects services it is extremely important for the end users to move away from vertical thinking focus expand on systems thinking a move that will address not only vertical network management needs but also horizontal business management needs
