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the adaptation of late latin grammars from the schools of the roman empire for use in a foreign christian society culminated in the british isles in the 7th and 8th centuries in the development of two distinct types of grammar designed respectively for elementary and for more advanced students these works whether they take the form of elaborate commentaries on the classical grammarians or of simple collections of paradigms reflect the reading and intellectual preoccupations of their authors

the first teachers in the west to face the problem of large scale formal foreign language teaching the influence of the insular grammarians extended far beyond their own time their works taken to the continent by irish and anglo saxon missionaries shaped both the latinity and the pedagogical technique of their pupils the carolingians and their influence in foreign language teaching has persisted until our own time

gegenstand dieses buches ist ein text welcher bisher der forschung was sein zeitliches und räumliches umfeld betrifft rätsel aufgegeben hat gleichwohl für das verständnis der spätantiken linguistik und ihr fortwirken im mittelalter wichtig ist es handelt sich um einen in der tradition des servius stehenden kommentar zur ars maior donats der bis heute unter dem namen des christlichen staatsmanns und schriftstellers cassiodor verbreitet ist die verfasserschaft ist dennoch ungeklärt weil die zuweisung an cassiodor weniger auf der Überlieferung beruht als vielmehr auf der gewagten theorie eines französischen philologen der den text im 17 jahrhundert erstmals ediert hat inhaltlich beschäftigt sich der traktat mit den octo partes orationis d h den acht wortarten nomen pronomen verb adverb partizip konjunktion präposition und interjektion für den heutigen benutzer war der text bisher nur schwer zugänglich weil der ersten und einzigen edition von 1679 und ihrem nachdruck von 1848 nur ein teil des Überlieferten zugrunde liegt am anfang der vorliegenden arbeit steht daher die neuedition des textes bei welcher gegenüber der älteren fassung eine noch existierende frühkarolingische handschrift sowie eine breite nebenüberlieferung berücksichtigt worden sind den zweiten teil bildet ein kommentar in dem der text sprachlich und inhaltlich untersucht wird mit dem ziel die fragen nach zeit und raum seiner entstehung seinem literaturgeschichtlichen umfeld seinem verfasser sowie seinem fortwirken zu klären der auf diese weise zeitlich und räumlich schärfer konturierte text kann die reihe der wenigen donatkommentare die aus der spätantike überliefert sind ergänzen und so der modernen linguistik als gegenstand zur erforschung der frühen stufen der sprachtheorie dienen

the study of manuscripts is fundamental to the appreciation of anglo saxon texts and culture anglo saxon manuscripts basic readings provides an introductory collection of materials covering basic terms techniques resources issues and applications focusing on manuscripts copied before 1100 in england the selections gathered here consider their history production analysis and significance drawn from a variety of published sources and new writings commissioned for this collection these essays offer a thorough background in principles and practices along with up to date coverage of new developments in paleography this interdisciplinary collection introduces key subjects of research for anglo saxon studies while suggesting potential developments and new directions within the field

significant anglo saxon papers with postscripts illustrate advances in knowledge of life and culture of pre conquest england thomas northcote toller of the bosworth toller anglo saxon dictionary is one of the most influential but least known anglo saxon scholars of the early twentieth century the centre for anglo saxon studies at manchester where toller was the first professor of english language has an annual toller lecture delivered by an expert in the field of anglo saxon studies this volume offers a selection from these lectures brought together for the first time and with supplementary material added by the authors to bring them up to date they are

Grammar and Grammarians in the Early Middle Ages is the only book in this field which examines linguistics in the Middle Ages from the standpoint of both the medievalist and the historian of linguistics primary source material along with previously unpublished texts are used extensively with all foreign texts translated into English and are listed in a useful bibliography to aid further study historical surveys author studies and introductions to medieval grammatical terminology are also included to help clarify the historical context of the study the volume will prove invaluable reading and an important reference work for those studying historical linguistics for medieval and cultural historians and to all who are interested in the intellectual life and literature of medieval Europe

Volume 124 of the Proceedings of the British Academy contains 19 obituaries of recently deceased fellows of the British Academy

This is an authoritative guide to the full range of medieval scholarship undertaken in twentieth-century Britain history archaeology language culture some of the twenty-nine essays focus on changes in research method or on the achievements of individual scholars others are personal accounts of a lifetime's work

Four very different kinds of Anglo-Saxon thinking are clarified in this volume traditions learned and oral about the settlement of the country study of foreign language grammar interest in exotic jewels as reflections of the glory of God and a mainly rational attitude to medicine publication of no less than three discoveries augments our corpus of manuscript evidence the nature of Old English poetry is illuminated and a useful summary of the editorial treatment of textual problems in Beowulf is provided a re-examination of the accounts of the settlement in Bede's *Historia ecclesiastica* and the Anglo-Saxon Chronicle yields insights into the processes of Anglo-Saxon learned historiography and oral tradition a thoroughgoing analysis of an under-studied major work Bald's Leechbook demonstrates that the compiler perhaps in King Alfred's reign translated selections from a wide range of Latin texts in composing a well-organized treatise directed against the diseases prevalent in his time the usual comprehensive bibliography of the previous year's publications in all branches of Anglo-Saxon studies rounds off the book

ziel der arbeit ist die möglichst vollständige dokumentation und diskussion des ins altenglische entlehnten griechischen wortmaterials dessen umfang bisher nicht annähernd abgeschätzt werden konnte als konkreten beitrag zur einzelwortforschung enthält sie ein etymologisches wörterbuch der griechischen lehnwörter mit über 250 einträgen und behandelt auch abgrenzung und problemfälle erstmals entsteht ein gesamtbild der entlehnungswege fast ausschließlich fungierte das latein als vermittlersprache gelehrt angelsächsische direktentlehnungen sind nicht bezeugt der vieldiskutierten gotischen vermittlung alten missionsvokabulars gilt ein eigener abschnitt die summe alter und neuer argumente zu der sich der altenglische befund stellt erweist die these als problematisch und verzichtbar

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
