Hypothesis Testing After estimating a regression model we need to test the significance of our findings Hypothesis testing allows us to determine whether the estimated coefficients are statistically different from zero implying a genuine relationship between variables We use p-values and confidence intervals to assess this For example a low p-value e.g. 0.05 suggests that the effect of an independent variable is statistically significant

Model Specification Choosing the right variables and functional form for your regression is crucial Incorrect specification can lead to biased and inconsistent estimates For example if we omit a relevant variable we might wrongly attribute its effect to other included variables omitted variable bias

Causality vs. Correlation Econometrics aims to establish causal relationships but correlation doesn't imply causation Just because two variables move together doesn't mean one causes the other Spurious correlations can arise due to omitted variables or other factors Consider ice cream sales and crime rates both increase in summer but one doesn't cause the other
