Paton Walsh shows that this activism involved some of the most prominent women of their day. Elizabeth Cutter Morrow, whose son-in-law Charles Lindbergh was an isolationist spokesman, supported the revision of the neutrality acts to allow the sale of arms to the allies and expressed her support in a national radio broadcast. Soon other women joined this debate. Esther Brunauer of the AAUW, journalist Dorothy Thompson, and organizations like the League of Women Voters and National Women's Trade Union League broke from the pacifist tradition to advocate American aid for the allied cause, focusing on the conflict in Europe. Paton Walsh shows how these women grasped the implications of the Lend-Lease program for America's entry into the war but supported it nevertheless. By late 1941, the Women's Division of the Fight for Freedom Committee had been established, no longer merely advocating aid to Britain to keep American boys out of battle.
