the quest to study topological spaces up to homotopy equivalence has a natural starting point we begin by asking which spaces are the least complicated from a homotopical perspective

we say that spaces  $x$   $y$  are homotopy equivalent and write  $x \sim y$  when there is a homotopy equivalence between them pointing in either direction the relation on spaces given by homotopy
