the tōkaidō road offers a comparative study of the tōkaidō road s representations during the edo 1600 1868 and meiji 1868 1912 eras throughout the edo era the tōkaidō highway was the most important route of japan and transportation was confined to foot travel in 1889 the tōkaidō railway was established at first paralleling and

eventually almost eliminating the use of the highway during both periods the tōkaidō was a popular topic of representation and was depicted in a variety of visual and literary media after the installation of the railway in the Meiji era the tōkaidō was presented as a landscape of progress modernity and westernisation such representations were fundamental in shaping the tōkaidō and the realm of travelling in the collective consciousness of the Japanese people
