the supreme court's controversial decision in *Oregon v. Smith* sharply departed from previous expansive readings of the first amendment's religious freedom clause and ignited a firestorm of protest from legal scholars, religious groups, legislators, and native Americans. A major event in native American history, the case attracted widespread support for the Indian cause from a diverse array of religious groups eager to protect their own religious freedom and led to an intense tug of war between the court and Congress.
